Senior Rider:	Rider 19 or older	WJL

**All Riders under 18 must wear a ASTM approved helmet, securely fastened, while mounted or otherwise handling a horse.**

**See show manager with any questions.**

1. Ribbons: First thru Sixth Place.
2. Negative Coggins is required.
3. Judging based on SSBC, AQHA, USEF rules.
4. All ties are broken by the Horsemanship Class.
5. All stallions must be handled by an adult (18 or older).
6. All riders must sign a SSBC "Waiver & Indemnity" Release form.
7. SSBC is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider or property.
8. Required: Appropriate dress, boots, tack and if under 18, an ASTM helmet.
9. Classes may be divided if entries warrant.
10. To qualify for End of day or Weekend High Point, same rider team is required to go in Showmanship, Pleasure and Horsemanship in their chosen division.
11. Trail and Grooming Classes are not required but do count toward High Point for the day and weekend.
12. Please advise Paddock Master if dropping a class, one class prior to dropped class.
13. A Novice is one who does not receive payment for training, lessons, etc.
14. A Ranch Horse is a working horse for which light contact and natural gaits are rewarded.
15. A Green Horse is one that has been showing for less than two years
