All Riders under 18 must wear a ASTM approved helmet, securely fastened, while mounted or otherwise handling a horse. See show manager with any questions.

- Ribbons: First thru Sixth Place.
- Negative Coggins is required.
- Judging based on SSBC, AQHA, USEF rules.
- All ties are broken by the Horsemanship Class.
- All stallions must be handled by an adult (18 or older).
- All riders must sign a SSBC "Waiver & Indemnity" Release form.
- SSBC is not responsible for loss or injury to a horse, rider or property.
- Required: Appropriate dress, boots, tack and if under 18, an ASTM helmet.
- Classes may be divided if entries warrant.

- 10. To qualify for End of day or Weekend High Point, same rider team is required to go in Showmanship, Pleasure and Horsemanship in their chosen division.
- Trail and Grooming Classes are not required but do count toward High Point for the day and weekend.
- Please advise Paddock Master if dropping a class, one class prior to dropped class.
- A Novice is one who does not receive payment for training, lessons, etc.
- A Ranch Horse is a working horse for which light contact and natural gaits are rewarded.
- 15. A Green Horse is one that has been showing for less than two years
